Rules for the 2012 Disc Golf Pro / Am World Championships

1. Sidewalk and asphalt (and across) to the right of the fairway are O.B.
Beyond the green, the sidewalk (and across) is O.B.
2. (no mando) Asphalt and across is O.B. to the right. Sidewalk and across to the left is O.B.
There is O.B. behind the green that runs into the ditch and then away from the green.
3. No O.B.
4. O.B. stakes are behind basket above and along the creek bed .
5. Across the chainlink fence at the top of the hill is O.B.
6. There is an O.B. line starting at the tee and running along the right side of the fairway , then tapering down to the base of the hill and along the edge of the creek. Across that line is O.B.
7. Mando! There is a mando just in front of tee. Retee if you miss the mando. O.B. lines the fairway to the right and also down the left in the creek bed. On or across the asphalt is O.B. up near the green. Please note that the O.B. line down the right side continues around the green all the way to the street.***
8. O.B. line along the swamp below the green.
9. In or across the creek is O.B.
10. O.B. lines the entire right side of the fairway. It also continues all the way to the green and around the right side of the green and the back side of the green per the red stakes and flags.
11. O.B. on right is staked and flagged. Road and across on left is O.B.
There is O.B. past the green also staked and flagged.
12. O.B. is staked and flagged on right side of the fairway.
Road and across to the left and behind the green is O.B.
13. O.B. is staked and flagged on the right side of the fairway.
14. O.B. line starts about ½ way down the right side of the fairway and continues on past the green in the woods.
15. Sidewalk and across is O.B. (Yes it has happened)
16. - 17. Water is casual.
18. Mando's on both towers. If missed, make next throw from the teepad in between the towers. O.B. runs down the right side of the fairway and then cuts up to the parking lot. Most of the hillside of the big ditch is O.B. as well as a swath in the center of the fairway from the road to the big ditch. Island green rules are in effect !!!
The disc must come to rest in bounds (inside or touching the gold hose) or else you play it from your previous lie or where it was last in bounds (not on the green).
