

Ongoing Developments

Course work continues daily at the International Disc Golf Center. As of the fall of 2006, the first of three courses has been installed and is now playable. The “Steady” Ed Memorial Course plays through the beautiful Georgia forest and along the banks of Clark Hill Lake. The impressive design has been well received by touring professionals and locals alike.

During winter 2006 a second major tree service operation will remove 2,000+ tree stumps from all three courses as well as clear the remaining debris. Following this work, all three courses will be ready for baskets, tee pads and other amenities. It will be a busy Winter, and an exciting Spring.



In addition to the work on the courses, steady progress has been made on the permanent IDGC headquarters. This 2,700 square foot building will include office space for the PDGA, the “Steady” Ed Headrick museum, Disc Golf Hall of Fame Museum, a snack bar, pro shop and other visitor friendly attractions. Look for information regarding the grand opening in Spring 2007.

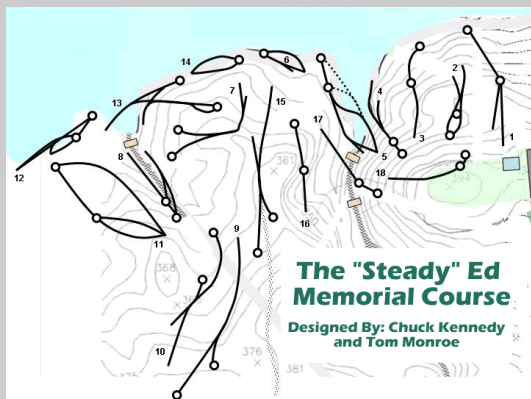

The Vision of the IDGC Project

The International Disc Golf Center, located at Wildwood Park in Columbia County, Georgia, is destined to be the world's showcase of disc golf course design, competition, and instruction. With a headquarters building, three world-class courses, a SkillShot facility, putting greens, training areas, and other amenities, the IDGC will become the premier destination for disc golf enthusiasts the world over.



Through a public/private partnership with Columbia County, 105 acres of land and the costs of constructing the building have generously been provided to the project. Disc golf's leading manufacturers have donated the targets, and our leading course designers have now completed the layouts for the three courses.



Tax Deductible Donations

It is, however, incumbent on the Association to provide and install the course and site enhancements necessary to meet the high standards expected by the membership and the playing public, including the IDGC site entrance, course entrances and information boards, tee pads, tee signs, benches, footbridges, water stations, shelters, landscaping, and building and site equipment.

To this end, the PDGA, in cooperation with the Disc Golf Foundation, has established an Endowment Fund, to which tax deductible contributions can be made, that will pay for the improvements and provide for ongoing maintenance and upkeep of the facility. Contributions to the fund may be made directly by or in memory or in honor of an individual, a family, or an organization. This could be the perfect way for you or your club to remember someone who made a difference to the disc golf community.
