



Event Format Rules

Round 1: *Stroke Play Singles* on the "Steady" Ed Headrick Memorial Course. Team points will be awarded based on overall order of finish, we will award points based on a proportion of teams. It will either be 1 point or ½ of a point for every player you beat (announced at player's meeting), all 4 scores will then be totaled for a team score for the round. First place team for this round will receive a bonus proportional to the number of teams (ties split bonus).

Round 2: *Match Play Singles* on the "Steady" Ed Headrick Memorial Course. This round is 18 holes or however many holes are needed to complete a win for the entire round. Players will be matched according to their finish place in round 1. All ties will be broken via highest PDGA number. Holes need to be won outright, any ties on individual hole results in a push for that hole and does not carry over. Total points awarded per match will be proportional to the number of teams entered in the tournament. For example: if there are 23 teams in the event each match will be worth 23 points. A team bonus proportional to the number of teams will be given if one team wins all 4 of their matches.

Round 3: *Best Shot Doubles* played on the Jim Warner Memorial Course. Each team captain will choose two doubles pairs from their team of four. Team captain must notate an A-Team and B-Team, **and submit doubles rosters to the TD by the end of day Saturday**. If you have a question about how to play best shot doubles please ask the TD. Team points will be awarded based on overall order of finish. This will again be proportional to the number of teams beat or tie multiplied 2. First place team for this round will receive a bonus proportional to the number of teams (ties split bonus).

Round 4: *TEAM Doubles Best/Alternate Shot* played on the WR Jackson Memorial Course. Team Doubles is played with two sets of teammates; one "ODD", one "EVEN". The ODD set will tee off on every odd-numbered hole, while the EVEN set tees off on all even-numbered holes. After the tee shots, the team chooses which of the two lies to play from and the set that did not tee throws their two shots. Again, the whole team decides which lie to play from and the set that teed off would throw. That alternating process continues until the hole is complete. On the next hole, the corresponding set of teammates, ODD or EVEN, would tee off no matter which set putted out on the previous hole. This format allows for each player to tee off the same amount of times and for teams to play as a whole. Points will be awarded based on the number of teams you beat multiplied by 10. First place team for this round will receive a bonus proportional to the number of teams (ties split bonus).
